The Bachelor | Magnum Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into The Bachelor | Magnum Competition (“Competition”) is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

Eligibility to Enter

2. Entry is open to all residents of Australia, 18 years and over. However, employees and the immediate families of Network Ten Pty Limited (the “Promoter”), Unilever Australia Limited (“Unilever”) and their associated agencies and companies or any organisation or individual associated with the provision of the prize(s) are not eligible to enter. Entrant must be residing in Australia at the time of entry, or their entry may be deemed invalid.

How to Enter

6. To participate in the Competition entrants must:

Log on to either tenplay.com.au/win and register their details including (but not limited to) name, address, phone number, email address, gender and date of birth, to become a 10 Play member or 10daily.com.au/win and provide their details including (but not limited to) the code word, name, address, phone number, email address, gender, date of birth and opt in to 10 Daily to receive further communications via email.
