2020 Junior MasterChef Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the 2020 Junior MasterChef Competition (“Competition”) is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

Eligibility to Enter

2. Entry is open to all residents of Australia. However, employees and the immediate families of Network Ten Pty Limited (the “Promoter”) and their associated agencies and companies or any organisation or individual associated with the provision of the prize(s) are not eligible to enter. Entrant must be residing in Australia at the time of entry, or their entry may be deemed invalid.

Competition Period

How to Enter

Specific details may vary, and may include (but not limited to) first name, last name, post code, phone number, email address, gender and date of birth, to become a 10 Play member; and
 - c. Nominate a local school or community club (“Nominee”), including but not limited to the club or school’s full name, address, suburb and state (local school refers to a registered early learning centre, primary or secondary school in Australia that has a canteen on its premise; community club refers to a not-for-profit organisation or association that provides sporting, recreational, educational, social, community development or health services in Australia that has access and use of a canteen);
 - d. Provide the relevant answer to the question in the entry form; and
 - e. Tick the checkbox to confirm that the Nominee has given permission to be nominated and agrees to these terms and conditions.

The Promoter does not take any responsibility for any tax consequences or imposts that arise from the receipt of the Prize.

23. The Winner will be required to provide the bank details of the nominated school or community club in writing to The Promoter. The Promoter will not be responsible for the Winner not receiving prize funds as a result of incorrect bank account details being supplied or other details affecting the transfer.
24. In acceptance of the prize, the Winner acknowledges that they may incur ongoing costs associated with the prize which are the entire responsibility of the Winner.
